Beehive Mug Rug Instructions 5x7 & 6x10

Supplies Needed:

1 Piece Printed or solid Fabric for backing

1 Piece Printed or solid Fabric for top

Colorful scrap for beehive applique

Thin batting

Thread

Medium tear away stabilizer

Adhesive if needed

Instructions:

Hoop Stabilizer, thin batting, and 1 layer of solid or printed fabric in this order from bottom up.

1. Run Color 1 (White outline stitch to hold layers together).

2. Run Colors 2-6 (Bee and wording and hive door)

3. Run Color 7 (Outline Stitch for beehive applique)

STOP

4. Place fabric down over the beehive outline. (Use adhesive if needed)

5. Run Color 8 (Tackdown stitch for beehive applique)

STOP

6. Remove hoop but **DO NOT UNHOOP**.

7. Cut away fabric to stitching line but do not cut into stitch line.

8. Replace unit.

9. Run Color 9 (Decorative stitching for beehive)

10. Run Colors 10 (Final satin stitch for beehive applique)

11. Run Colors 11 (Decorative top stitch for beehive applique)

STOP

11. Float backing fabric underneath hoop.

12. Run Color 12 (white reinforcement stitches)

STOP

13. Remove hoop but DO NOT UNHOOP.

14. Cut away fabric to stitching line.

DO NOT CUT into the stabilizer. It should stay intact to support the final step.

15. **Replace unit.**

16. Run Colors 13-14 (Dark Yellow Light Gray Rope Stitch)

STOP

17. Remove from hoop and gently cut and tear away remaining stabilizer.

18. Press with cloth on top.
