## July Mug Rug Instructions 5x7 hoop size

### Supplies Needed:

1 Piece Printed Fabric for Backing  
1 Piece White Fabric for top  
Thin batting, Thread, Medium tear away stabilizer  
Adhesive if needed

### Instructions:

1. Hoop Stabilizer, thin batting, and 1 layer of white fabric in this order from bottom up.
2. Run Color 1 (Pale Yellow outline stitch)
3. Run Color 2 (White Outline Stitch for JULY Letters)

#### **STOP.**

4. Place fabric over outlines. Use adhesive securing fabric.
5. Run Color 3 (Gray Tack Down Stitch for JULY Letters)

#### **STOP.**

#### **6. Remove hoop but DO NOT UNHOOP.**

7. Trim stitching to about 1/8 of stitch line. This is a frayed edge applique.

#### **8. Replace hoop.**

9. Run Color 4 (Gray puzzle stitching)
10. Run Color 5 (RED Final Applique Outline Stitching for JULY Letters)

#### **STOP.**

11. Float printed piece of fabric under the hoop. Use adhesive to secure if needed.
12. Run Color 6 (light gray outline basting stitch)

#### **STOP.**

#### **13. Remove hoop but DO NOT UNHOOP.**

14. Cut away fabric to stitching line.

#### **DO NOT CUT into the stabilizer. It should stay intact to support the final step.**

15. Replace unit.
16. Run Color 7 (RED Final Outline stitch)
17. Remove from hoop and gently tear away remaining stabilizer.
18. Press with cloth on top.
19. Gently fray letter edges.

## July Mug Rug Instructions 4x4 hoop size

### Supplies Needed:

1 Piece Printed Fabric for Back Fabric  
1 Piece of White Fabric or White Felt for top  
Thread, 2 sheets Medium tear away stabilizer (1 if using felt above)  
Adhesive if needed

### Instructions:

1. Hoop Stabilizer, and one layer of white fabric or felt in this order from bottom up.
2. Run Color 1
3. Run Color 2 (Gray puzzle outline)

### **STOP**

4. Float printed piece of fabric under the hoop. Use adhesive to secure if needed.
5. Run Color 3-4 (White Outline and Gray Reinforcement stitches)

### **6. Remove hoop but DO NOT UNHOOP.**

7. Cut away fabric to stitching line. DO NOT CUT into the stabilizer. It should stay intact to support the final step.

### **8. Replace unit.**

9. Run Color 5 RED Final Satin stitch.
10. Remove from hoop and gently tear away remaining stabilizer.
11. Press with cloth on top.
